Prepare Your Quilt Square

- + Select a piece of cotton fabric in a light color (so the message is readable).
- + Cut it into a 10x10-inch square. (Use a ruler and fabric scissors for accuracy.)
- + Leave a ½-inch border around the edges so your message is not sewn into the seam.




Write Your Message

- + Use a black, fabric-safe Sharpie to ensure the writing stays visible.
- + Keep your message short, positive, and focused on what you want leaders to do.



Do not write on the outer ½ inch of the square. Writing in that area will not be visible to a reader!

- + Avoid personal attacks or negativity this is about constructive advocacy.
- + If you're comfortable, sign your first name and state at the bottom.





Mail Your Square

- + Before you drop it in the mail, take a picture and share your photo on social media using #PeaceByPiece and @womenbuildingpeace to inspire others!
- + Place your fabric square in an envelope and send it to either address:
